Symposiums:

AFM associates may propose a symposium within the topic areas, by registering in the website (www.afm-ac.mx).

This is the required information:

- a) Symposium name.
- b) Topic Area.
- c) Symposium organizer: Name and Institution.
- d) Symposium profile: a description in 1500 words maximum.
- e) Name and Institution of every participant: each one of them will register himself in the website.

Papers submission:

To submit a paper the author will need to provide the following information:

- a) General information according to the submission format.
- b) Topic area for the submission.
- c) An abstract of minimum 1000 words and maximum 1500.
- d) Between 3 and 5 key words.

Posters:

The same requirements apply for a poster submission.

Books, journals and projects presentations:

Registration should be made in the Association's website, and should meet the following requirements:

- a) Publication date for books and journals should be between 2017 and 2018.
- b) Complete reference.
- c) Projects must be created recently, or its execution must be close.
- d) For all the cases, it should be indicated the names and adscriptions of the commentators (maximum three).

Important dates:

January 23: Call of paper publication and opening for papers submit.

May 12: Closure for paper submission.

June 24: Admission letters sending.

August 26: General program publication.

November 12: Conference inauguration.

Costs:

Down to August 31, 2018:

- AFM members without debts: no cost.
- Presenters (papers or posters) with residence in México: \$ 1,200.00 MN (Mil doscientos pesos MN).
- Presenters (papers or posters) with abroad residence: \$ 65.00 USD (Sesenta y cinco USD).
- Mexican students with student ID: \$ 400.00 MN (Cuatrocientos pesos MN).
- Foreigner students with student ID: \$ 25,00 USD (Veinticinco USD).
- Attendees with residence in México and right to Certificate: \$ 600.00 MN (Seiscientos pesos MN).
- Foreigner attendees with right to Certificate: \$ 32.00 USD (Treinta y dos USD).

From September 1, 2018:

- Mexican students with student ID: \$ 450.00 MN (Cuatrocientos cincuenta pesos MN).
- Foreigner students with student ID: \$ 28,00 USD (Veintiocho USD).
- Attendees with residence in México and right to Certificate: \$ 675.00 MN (Seiscientos setenta y cinco pesos MN).
- Foreigner attendees with right to Certificate: \$ 36.00 USD (Treinta y seis USD).
